1. Befriending and Support

Home-Start Colchester continues to provide an essential Befriending Service to parents across Colchester and South Tendring currently via phone calls, emails and texts. If you are struggling and need someone to listen, to care and offer support, Home-Start is here for you.



2. Getting essential items to families in need:

Home-Start Colchester successfully applied and secured small grants to benefit families directly. We have created Essential goods bags bespoke to each family's requests

- Nappies
- Wipes
- Toiletries
- Cleaning items
- Games
- Books
- Snacks
- Toys





3. Help with completing forms or applying for benefits

5. Online parenting programs with co-ordinators support






Parents are finding themselves in a unique situation of having their children at home and confined to the house. All these added stressors could interfere with how they interact with their children and put more pressure on their parenting.

More than ever, parents need support. We can provide a log on key for the


Triple P online parenting courses.

6. Food—Distributing Foodbank vouchers and when needed we collect and deliver food to families.



Home-Start is working in partnership by distributing Foodbank vouchers to families. You can collect at our offices at The Ark, Highwoods or The Mill Old Rd Clacton.

We are also able if needed to collect and deliver food to your family home. We can often combined this with our essential goods to help families manage through these difficult times.

7. Reducing Parental Conflict

Home-Start is able to provide advice and guidance to support families with many issues . We currently deliver the Reducing Parental Conflict Program. In partnership with Tavistock Institute of Medical Psychology trading as Tavistock Relationships (Tavistock) .



8. Personal parenting support

9. Small grants for vulnerable families in need

The charity has a small bursary to help families who need help in a crisis.

The Linda Steers fund was set up to help families struggling when there are no other grants or loans to help. We provide a grant between £10.00—£500. The grant offer is decided by the board and can be used for various items or situations to resolve difficulties for registered Home-Start Colchester's supported families.



10. Volunteering
